

Contractions with the verb 'To Be'

To make a contraction with a subject pronoun and the verb Be, join the two words and replace the first letter of the conjugated verb BE with an apostrophe.

Words	Contraction
I am	I'm
You are	You're
He is	He's
She is	She's
It is	It's
We are	We 're
They are	They're
That is	That's
These are	These're
There are	There're
Who is	Who's
What is	What's
Where is	Where're
When is	When's
Why is	Why's
How are	How're

Engodic

Contractions with 'Would'

Contraction with would is very simple, just replace letters 'woul-' with an apostrophe (').

Words	Contraction
I would	I'd
You would	You'd
He would	He'd
She would	She'd
It would	It'd
We would	We 'd
They would	They'd
That would	That'd
These would	These'd
There would	There'd
Who would	Who'd
What would	What'd
Where would	Where'd
When would	When'd
Why would	Why'd
How would	How'd

Contractions with ‘Had’

Contraction with had is exactly same as with would, just replace ‘Ha-’ of Had with Apostrophe.

Words		Contraction
I had		I’d
You had		You’d
He had		He’d
She had		She’d
It had		It’d
We had		We ‘d
They had		They’d
That had	Enodidic	That’d
These had		These’d
There had		There’d
Who had		Who’d
What had		What’d
Where had		Where’d
When had		When’d
Why had		Why’d
How had		How’d

Contractions with ‘Not’

In most cases of Contraction with ‘Not’ we Mostly Replace ‘O’ of Not with an Apostrophe.

Note:

Contraction of ‘will not’ & ‘Shall Not’ is a little different.

Will Not ----- Won’t

Shall Not -----Shan’t

Words	Contraction
Is not	Isn’t
Are not	Aren’t
Was not	Wasn’t
Were not	Weren’t
Must not	Mustn’t
Will not	Won’t
Would not	Wouldn’t
Dose not	Doesn’t
Do not	Don’t
Did not	Didn’t
Can not	Can’t
Could not	Couldn’t
Shall not	Shan’t
Should not	Shouldn’t
Is not	Isn’t
Are not	Aren’t

Engodic

Contractions with ‘Has/Have’

Have is used with I, you, we, and they, while **has** is used with he, she, and it.

Words	Contraction
I have	I’ve
We have	We’ve
You have	You’ve
He has	He’s
She has	She’s
It has	It’s
They have	They’ve

Without contraction: It has been a Lovely Evening.
With Contraction: It’s been a Lovely Evening.
