common noun is being used to indicate a class of something then 'the' is used before that noun.




He is most intelligent boy in the class.

'The' is used before the names of river, oceans, seas etc, groups of Islands, not before an individual island and it is used before ranges of mountains not before a single mountain.






Rule 5

'The' is not used before common nouns in plural number.
